Copper River In-Season Salmon Teleconference –

Key Updates:

- Tracy Hansen, ADFG- Sonar Counts (Miles Lake ended July 28):
 - 4,900 king salmon
 - 10,700 sockeye salmon
- Sport Fishing: Catch-and-release king salmon fishing open until August 10.
- Amber Cohen, NPS- Permits:
 - 566 permits issued for the upper Copper River District (above average).
 - Subsistence effort tapering off as focus shifts toward moose season.
- Kelsey Stanbro, AITRC- Health Assessment:
 - Positive salmon health results so far.
 - One dip net charter in Chitina completed; two more are operating until August 16.
 - Fish beginning to turn red; many fish wheels are being pulled.
- Subsistence Reports:
 - High river levels are affecting some fish wheels.
 - Example shared of a fish wheel stuck due to a large tree in the river.
